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About the Organizing Institute

The **Veterinary College, Hebbal, Bengaluru**, was inaugurated on July 25, 1958, and celebrated its Golden Jubilee from September 2007 to August 2008. The college strives to align veterinary education with societal needs and the aspirations of livestock farmers. The Department of Poultry Science, Veterinary College, Bangalore, is a pioneer in catering to the needs of the farming community and the poultry industry. More than 350 postgraduates in the discipline of Poultry Science have graduated from this department, and over 50 doctoral students have earned their degrees here. The first IPSACON was organized by this department in 1971, followed by in the year 1995. Now, in 2026, the department is once again hosting this prestigious IPSACON. Our major contributions include the development of the new variety Giriraja for rural poultry in 1989, and Swarnadhara for backyard poultry in 2006. Beyond research, the department is actively involved in conducting regular training programs, workshops, hands-on training, and skill development initiatives for farmers, entrepreneurs, and students.

The **Indian Poultry Science Association (IPSA)**, founded in March 1965, is a registered body dedicated to advancing poultry science and promoting sustainable poultry development in India. With nearly 1,900 members, IPSA brings together scientists, researchers, educators, students, entrepreneurs, and industry professionals from diverse poultry-related sectors. A major achievement is the Indian Journal of Poultry Science (IJPS), launched in 1966, which remains a leading peer-reviewed journal, now published digitally in collaboration with ICAR-DKMA. IPSA organizes national symposia, seminars, and technical meetings, having conducted 40 such events to date, fostering dialogue on poultry production, marketing, and welfare. It also recognizes excellence through awards, fellowships, and honors such as the Ayurved Award, Young Scientist Award, and Lifetime Achievement Award. Governed by an Executive Committee of elected and nominated professionals. Over six decades, IPSA has played a pivotal role in shaping India's poultry sector into a socially attractive, environmentally responsible, and economically viable profession.
